

Dear Family,

The Pre-K Language & Literacy Screener is a screening tool that measures young children's language and literacy development. For 4-year-olds, the screener contains subtests that measure six broad skills, which impact later reading achievement:

Alphabet Knowledge: knowledge of letter names and letter sounds

Phonological Awareness: the ability to play with and hear the sounds of language

Language Comprehension: showing understanding of a story by using words (expressive) and by using gestures like

pointing (receptive)

Emergent Writing: ability to write their name

Print Concepts: understanding of how print, books, and writing work

Processing: ability to get information from memory quickly and easily

Across the year, the subtests for Pre-K4 include:

Print Concepts	Print Concepts	Using a little book, children show how to turn pages, follow words across a page, and position a book	10
